Celebrating Leadership: Kelly Brenton Wins 2024 Max Award for Women in Mining

Kelly didn't set out to work in mining. With a Master's in Business and 20 years in the private sector, she joined De Beers Canada and now leads as Manager of Social Performance at the Gahcho Kué Mine.

Since 2020, Kelly has been a driving force behind De Beers' Building Forever goal of Accelerating Equal Opportunity. She's a founding member of the NWT Women in Mining Chapter and a key advocate for equity both locally and globally.

- STEM camps and pre-trade training for women
- Support for NWT communities during COVID-19 and the 2023 wildfires
